Topic: MUNICIPAL SERVICES INSTALLATION REGULATIONS-ROADS

Policy Statement:

The following regulations are municipal additions to the 'Government of Newfoundland and Labrador Municipal Water, Sewer and Roads Standards' and are to be adhered to within Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay boundaries. These specifications and regulations shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Municipal Engineer or his/her designate.

ROADS:

- 1. The paved surface of a road shall have graveled shoulders not less than 2 meters wide and parallel to the pavement where there are no sidewalks or walkways.
- 2. Where the paved surface is paralleled by a curb and sidewalk or walkway, the graveled shoulder shall be a minimum of 3 meters in width.
- 3. Where a storm drainage system is required (e.g. a curb and sidewalk installed) a weeping field must be installed within the road right-of-way as per Town specifications.
