Topic: RIGHT OF WAY

Policy Statement:

The following regulations are municipal additions to the 'Government of Newfoundland and Labrador Municipal Water, Sewer and Roads Standards' and are to be adhered to within Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay boundaries. These specifications and regulations shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Municipal Engineer or his/her designate.

- 1. No Person or Persons shall plant grass or other materials within 1.5 meters (5 feet) of the pavement.
- 2. Grass and or other materials that are presently within 1.5 meters (5 feet) of the pavement will be removed by the Town Employees after notification has been given to the home owners. Grass and other materials will be replaced by crushed stone.
- 3. A Person or Persons may plant grass or other materials in the remaining part of the RIGHT OF WAY outside their property line, with the written permission of the Town of Happy Valley Goose Bay.
- The Town of Happy Valley Goose Bay will not be responsible for any damage to any grass or other material planted in the RIGHT OF WAY, while carrying out services.
- 5. The Town of Happy Valley Goose Bay reserves the right to carry out it duties in providing services within its RIGHT OF WAYS.
