Topic: TOWN LANDFILL SITE

## **Policy Statement:**

- The gate at the Landfill Site shall be closed and locked at all times except when stated in This Policy
- 2. Gate will be open from Monday Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- 3. A tipping fee will be charged, as per section F0005 Miscellaneous Rates of the Policy & Procedures Manual.
- 4. A dump attendant shall man the guard directing traffic where to dump and shall collect the tipping Fees;
- 5. Any special handling/supervision required shall be recovered at cost plus 20%;
- 6. There shall be no scavenging permitted at the landfill site;
- 7. The Town Contractor for garbage collection shall be supplied with key to the gate;
- 8. There will be no burning at the Towns Landfill Site;
- 9. Hazardous Material will not be accepted at the Landfill Site;
  - 9.a. When Hazardous Materials are found on site, they shall be removed and placed in a designated holding area.

Topic: TOWN LANDFILL SITE Continued

## **Policy Statement:**

- 10. All hydrocarbons, coolants and ozone depleting substances must be removed/purged from derelict vehicles and/or equipment machinery prior to placement in the "scrap metals" designated area and placed into containers or a storage tank system.
- 11. Off road tires only will be accepted at the Landfill Site;
- 13. Waste shall be covered with sand as soon as practical.

Any contract in place prior to this policy being implemented shall be exempt from any tipping fee for that contract.
