Topic: NOTIFICATION OF BOIL WATER ADVISORY

Policy Statement:

Town of Happy Valley- Goose Bay is responsible for contacting Government Services and the users that are affected by a Boil Water Advisory.

A mass email contact list will be sent out and notification by the Town's Superintendent of Water and Sewer or Superintendent of Public Works in his absence. The Confidential Secretary or Office staff will post notification of the Boil Water Advisory on the Town's Web Site, Radio, Roll up Ad Channel and Face Book.

Testing by Town staff will start as soon as the water is turned back on and Bacteriological Samples will be presented to the hospital lab for analysis.

The Boil Water Advisory will remain in effect until notification from Government Services that the two consecutive samples are satisfactory in a twenty four hour period. The Town will follow the same procedure noted above to advise the public once the Boil Water Advisory has been lifted.
