
**TOPIC: RESIDENTIAL/ COMMERCIAL LAWN SWEEPING**

**Policy Statement:**

1. There is a significant build-up of sand on residential/ commercial properties because of road snow clearing operations conducted by the Town.
2. The intent of this initiative is to subsidize owners for a portion of the cost of the rental of a lawn sweeper or employment of a contractor to remove sand that has been deposited onto a residential/ commercial property through Town operations. Removal and disposal of sand will be the responsibility of the property owner.
3. The maximum subsidy will be \$50.00 per calendar year. Credits will be issued to the owner by registered participating businesses operating in the Town and payment to these businesses will be made on a monthly basis upon submission of invoices.
4. Property owners should be cognizant of the potential impact of noise, dust and debris on neighbouring properties and that all sand removal should be in accordance with the Town's Development Regulations.
