

# MONTHLY POLICING REPORT March 2022 Happy Valley-Goose Bay RCMP Detachment "B" Division Newfoundland and Labrador





**TO:** Mayor and Council, Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador.

The Happy Valley-Goose Bay RCMP Detachment responded to a total of 458 occurrences, which were classified as calls for service during March 2022, compared to 343 occurrences in 2021.

A total of 144 persons were incarcerated for a variety of Offences during the month of March.

## Annual Performance Plan (A.P.P.'S) Community Priorities

- (1) Enhance Road Safety Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement;
- (2) Crime Reduction Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property;
- (3) Community Relations Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community

Happy Valley Goose Bay RCMP will begin planning for the 2022/2023 Annual Performance Plan to assign priorities and goals for Detachment members to focus their proactive duties. The progress of this plan will be monitored throughout the year with progress reported on Quarterly. We will seek input from Mayor and Council to help direct these priorities for the surrounding area.

(1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement Goals have been set for improved Traffic initiatives, with increased traffic enforcement and regular checkstops to help combat Impaired Driving. Members conducted Two Checkstops, utilizing Mandatory Alcohol Screening. No Impaired Drivers were located during these stops. Members continue to conduct proactive vehicle stops for traffic safety issuing SOTs under the Highway Traffic Act when/where applicable.

The ADSE is a new device and we continue to provide the required training to Detachment Members to utilize it. This roadside device will allow officers to test subjects who may also be impaired by drug to further pursue charges in these instances

### (2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property

Goals have been set for proactive initiatives to help reduce crimes against persons and property. Detachment members implemented additional measures to monitor persons bound by court orders to ensure compliance. Members continue to conduct routine compliance checks ensuring persons are abiding. Due to the increase in crimes through social media/computers, members will be seeking opportunities to educate persons on crimes related to Fraud and Cybercrime.

# (3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community

Detachment Commander will ensure there is regular contact and communication with Mayor and Council to ensure any issues are brought forward and plans made to address. Detachment Commander will also ensure regular contact is maintained with the HVGB C/Cst. Detachment members continue to try and increase contact with the local youth with regular contact/visits made to local schools. School Liaisons have been appointed to maintain contact with Local Schools.

\*\*\*\*The APP is the main objective, outside of responding to calls for service, of the Detachment and helps direct members efforts each and every day.\*\*\*\*

### **Notable Investigations:**

2022263064 – Arson – On March 2<sup>nd</sup> HVGB RCMP received a report of a Cabin that was believed to have been set on fire. Information received advised that a person on skidoo was in the area fled after a loud bang. Investigation is ongoing

2022264067 – Assault with a Weapon - On March 3<sup>rd</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a Disturbance at the residence. Upon attending it was learned that a male had been assaulted with a weapon by a 35 year old male. Members arrested the male who has been charged with Assault with a Weapon and Resisting Arrest. Matter is before the courts.

2022268110 – Break and Enter - On March 3<sup>rd</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a disturbance where it was advised that female was breaking into the living space of other persons. Members attended and arrested a 26 year old female who has been charged with Break and Enter, Mischief(Damage to Property), and Forcible Entry. Matter is before the courts

2022272105 – Sexual Assault – On March 4<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a Sexual Assault. Investigation resulted in a 47 year old male being arrested and charged with Sexual Assault. Matter is before the courts.

2022302803 – Sexual Assault – On March 11<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a disturbance. Upon attending it was learned that a 37 year old male had sexually assaulted a female. The male was arrested and held in custody on the charges. Matter is before the courts.

2022313183 – Sexual Assault – On March 13<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP began an investigation into a report that a 22 year old male had sexually assaulted two other males at a private gathering. Investigation resulted in two charges of sexual assault against the 22 year old male. Matter is before the courts.

2022327863 – Assault Causing Bodily Harm - On March 16<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP members were on patrol when they located a male attacking another male in the street. A 35 Year old male was arrested for Assault Causing Bodily Harm. The victim received medical treatment. The matter is before the courts

2022349212 – Assault - On March 21<sup>st</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a disturbance at a residence. Upon attending members learned that a 36 year old male had assault a female. Members arrested the 36 year old male and he was brought before the courts on charges of Assault While Choking, Assault, Uttering Threats, and Breach of a Court Order.

2022382635 – Sexual Assault – On March 28<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP received a report that a victim had been sexually assaulted. Investigation resulted in a 37 year old male being arrested for Sexual Assault and Uttering Threats. The male was held for court and remanded into custody. Matter is before the courts.

2022401607 – Assault with a Weapon - On March 31<sup>st</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a disturbance in which it was reported that a 49 year old female had assaulted a male with a weapon. Upon attending members arrested a 49 year old female and she has been charged for Assault with a Weapon. Victim received medical treatment for his injuries. Matter is before the courts

HVGB Detachment and its members continue to deal with and adjust to the new realities of Covid-19 which continues to evolve. With the rollout of the vaccine we, along with everyone, are hoping a return to regular activities for all.

Happy Valley-Goose Bay RCMP wishes to thank our citizens for all of their assistance in combating crime and making our Community a safe one.
