A total of 213 persons were incarcerated for a variety of Offences during the month of September.

Annual Performance Plan (A.P.P.'S) Community Priorities

- (1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement;**
- (2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property;**
- (3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community**

The 2022/2023 Happy Valley Goose Bay RCMP Annual Performance Plan has been set with final updates on assigned priorities and goals which help us focus on the above noted areas. The progress of this plan will be monitored throughout the year.

(1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement

Goals have been set for improved Traffic initiatives, with increased traffic enforcement and regular checkstops to help combat Impaired Driving. Members will seek opportunities to conduct strategic checkpoints and partner with Traffic Services to combat Impaired Drivers and HTA Offences. Members will also be looking to conduct ATV Patrols during the summer and Skidoo Patrols during the Winter.

(2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property

Goals have been set for proactive initiatives to help reduce crimes against persons and property. Detachment members will undertake to implement additional measures to monitor persons bound by court orders to ensure compliance. Regular compliance checks will be conducted on persons bound by Court Imposed Conditions to ensure compliance.

(3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community

Detachment Commander will ensure there is regular contact and communication with Mayor and Council to ensure any issues are brought forward and plans made to address any identified issues. Detachment Commander will also ensure regular contact is maintained and meetings planned with partner agencies to seek opportunities to work together and help resolve any arising issues. Detachment members continue to try and increase contact with the local youth with regular contact/visits made to local schools. School Liaisons have been appointed to maintain contact with Local Schools

otable Investigations:

20221267593 – Assault with a Weapon – On Sept 3rd HVGB RCMP responded to a disturbance where it was learned that a male had assaulted another male while threatening him. RCMP arrested a 44 year old male for charges of Assault with a Weapon. Matter is before the courts

20221288060 – Sexual Assault – On Sept 7th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a disturbance. Upon attending it was learned that a female victim had been sexually assaulted. Members arrested a 42 year old male on scene who is facing charges of Sexual Assault

20221295765 – Assault with a Weapon – On Sept 8th HVGB RCMP responded to a incident in which it was reported that a female resident attempted to assault another resident with a weapon. Members located and arrested the female suspect who is facing charges of Assault with a Weapon

20221313860 – Possession of a Weapon for Dangerous Purpose – On Sept 11th HVGB RCMP responded to a report that a male had attended a residence armed with a weapon. Members attended and were able to arrest a 44 year old male for possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose and Mischief – Causing Damage

20221328540 – On Sept 14th HVGB RCMP were advised of an assault which occurred a couple days prior. Upon investigation it was learned that a female victim had been sexually assaulted. RCMP arrested a 19 year old male for Sexual Assault and charges were laid. This matter is before the courts

20221326282 – Impaired Operation – On Sept 14th HVGB RCMP members were on patrol and conducted a traffic stop which resulted in an impaired investigation. A 43 year old male failed a roadside test and was arrested for Impaired Operation. The male suspect provided breath samples over the legal limit and will be facing charges of Impaired Operation and Over 80

20221365715 – Assault with a Weapon – On Sept 21st HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a group of persons drinking in public. Upon attending RCMP arrested a 37 Year old male for assaulting another male with a weapon. The suspect was remanded into custody and the matter is before the courts

20221363209 – Aggravated Assault – On Sept 21st HVGB RCMP received a report of an injured male who had been assaulted. The male was located and transported to the Hospital for Medical Treatment and was later released. The matter remains under investigation and charges are pending

20221369052 – Break and Enter – On Sept 22nd HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a Break and Enter at a local business. Members attended the area and arrested a 22 year old female for Break and Enter. The female will be appearing in court at a later date in regards to the charges

20221388025 – Missing Person – On Sept 25th HVGB RCMP and the Military Police were advised of a Missing 24 year old male. HVGB GSAR was activated which included Aerial Support. After an extensive 5 Day Search, GSAR was able to locate the missing person who was sent for medical treatment

20221401537 – Assault PO - On Sept 27th HVGB RCMP members were on patrol when they located a male intoxicated in public. The 32 year old male was arrested and during the interaction with Police the male subject assaulted one of the officers. The male was later released and will be appearing in court at a later date for charges of Assaulting a Police Officer

20221396811 – Impaired Operation – On Sept 27th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a disturbance outside a residence where the suspect left in a vehicle. Members located the vehicle

and the 36 year old male driver was arrested for impaired operation. The male provided breath samples over twice the legal limit and is facing Charges of Impaired Operation and Over 80
