

## MONTHLY POLICING REPORT March 2023 Happy Valley-Goose Bay RCMP Detachment "B" Division Newfoundland and Labrador





**TO:** Mayor and Council, Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador.

The Happy Valley-Goose Bay RCMP Detachment responded to a total of 599 occurrences, which were classified as calls for service during March 2023, compared to 466 occurrences in 2022.

A total of 189 persons were incarcerated for a variety of Offences during the month of March

This plan will designate assigned priorities and goals which help the Detachment focus on goals/objectives that were assigned through consultation with Mayor and Town Council and with RCMP Divisional and National Priorities. The progress of this plan will be monitored throughout the year.

## **Notable Investigations:**

2023289513 – Assault while Choking – On March 4<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an assault. Members attended and learned that the victim had attempted to flee a residence but was caught by the suspect where she was assaulted and brought back to the residence in which they were staying. Members located and arrested the 21 year old male who was charged with Assault while Choking, Assault, Mischief Under \$5000, and Kidnapping

2023305323 – Assault With a Weapon – On March 7<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a domestic disturbance that involved a male, using a vehicle, striking another vehicle before departing the scene. Upon attending members arrested a 22 year old male for assault with a weapon, Failure to stop after an Accident, Dangerous Operation of a Motor Vehicle, Mischief Under \$5000. The male was held in custody and brought before the court.

2023332999 – Impaired Operation – On March 13<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP was alerted to a possible impaired driver. Members located the suspect vehicle and arrested a 44 year old male. The male provided breath sample which were over twice the legal limit. The male is facing charges of Impaired Operation, his vehicle was towed, and licence suspended.

2023352814 – Fail to stop After Accident – On March 17<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a disturbance at a residence. Members attended, but the suspect had fled the scene after using his vehicle to cause damage to another vehicle. Members later arrested a 33 year old male who has been charged with Fail to Stop after an Accident, Mischief Under \$5000, Breach of Probation, and Uttering Threats.

2023368250 – False Fire Alarm – On March 20<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP attended a local business after a 32 year old female pulled the Fire Alarm and left the building. There was no ongoing incident that would justify activating the fire alarm. The female has been charged with False Fire Alarm

2023398515 – Assault Causing Bodily Harm – On March 27<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an altercation where parties were uncooperative. Members were able to view security cameras which showed a 26 year old male assaulting a female. Members arrested the 26 Year Old Male who has been charged with Assault while Choking and Assault.

2023398586 – Impaired Operation – On March 27<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP conducted a routine traffic stop which resulted in the driver being arrested for Impaired Operation after failing a roadside test. The 41 year old female provided breath samples over the legal limit. The female is facing charges of Impaired Operation, her vehicle was towed, and licence suspended.

2023402638 – Disobey Court Order – On March 28<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP became aware of information that a 31 year old male was in breach of court imposed conditions to remain away from a female youth. Members attended the residence and under the authority of a Search Warrant entered the home and arrested the male. The female youth was present. The male has been charged with several counts of failing to comply with a court order and Disobeying a court order. The male remains in custody

2023414197 – Break and Enter – On March 30<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a Break and Enter at a local facility. Members were able to ID the suspects and have arrested and charged a 31 year old male and a 28 year old male, both have been charged with Break and Enter. Both matters are before the courts.

2023413200 – Disarming a Police Officer – On March 30<sup>th</sup> HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an intoxicated male in public. When members attempted to arrest the 31 year old male, he assaulted the officer and attempted to disarm the officer. Members were able to secure the male in handcuffs and he was held in custody to be brought before the court. The male is facing charges of Assault on Police, Resist Arrest, Disarming a Police Officer, Breach of Probation, and Fail to Comply with a Court Order. The male remains in custody
