CIVIC NUMBERS

Proper posting of civic numbers helps emergency responders, taxis and delivery vehicles find your address. Civic numbers can be purchased locally.

Here are some rules to follow.

Civic numbers **MUST**:

- be posted on the front of your home, business or subsidiary apartment
- be **VISIBLE** by street both day and night!
- be at least 4inches tall

2017 TAXES

It's easy to pay your taxes with **ONLINE BILL PAYMENT** available through RBC, BMO, Scotiabank and Eagle River Credit Union. How to:

- 1) Search for "HAPPY VALLEY-GOOSE BAY" in payee section.
- 2) Add Payee
- 3) Account #: last 8 digits of your Assessment Roll number, plus 000

Is the NAME & ADDRESS on your tax bill wrong?

Property Tax Relief

Residential property owners may be eligible for a tax relief. Complete the *Property Tax Low Income Relief* application form and submit to Town Hall with a copy of the CRA 2015 Notice of Assessment for each person residing at the address.

Tax Rebate

Seasonal recreational property owners may be eligible for a tax rebate (available on our website).

Businesses

All businesses, including home-based businesses, **MUST** be registered with the Town.

Organic Waste

Have yard waste, trees, trimmings, leaves or other untreated wood materials you want to get rid of? Bring them down to our Municipal Yard Waste Area on Courte Real Rd. and we'll turn your waste into chips used throughout the community!



Household Hazardous Waste

Residential hazardous waste can be brought to the landfill for proper disposal on Saturdays from 8am - 5pm. Commercial and Industrial waste **NOT** accepted. Garbage bins are available for purchase at Hickey's Construction: 5 Broomfield St. (896-3250)
