NOISE REGULATIONS

The following Regulations have been made by the Town Council of the Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay, under the provisions of the *Municipalities* Act, 1999, SNL 1999, c. M-24.

NOISE REGULATIONS

- 1. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (a) "Act" means the Municipalities Act, 1999, SNL 1999 c. M-24;
 - (b) "Council" means the Town Council of the Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay constituted under the provisions of the *Municipalities Act*, 1999, SNL 1999, c. M-24:
 - (c) "Noise" means any loud sound which is disturbing to people;
 - (d) "Regulations" mean these Noise Regulations; and,
 - (e) "Town" means the Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay as defined under the *Act* and/or any Regulations or Orders made pursuant thereto.
- No person within a motor vehicle shall play loud music, holler in excessive amount or otherwise make noise so as to disturb people or cause a nuisance or distraction within the Town.
- 3. No person shall squeal their tires within the Town.
- 4. No person within the Town shall use their lawn mower, chainsaw or electrical equipment which causes excessive Noise between the hours of 9 p.m. and 8 a.m.
- 5. No person within the Town shall allow his or her dog to bark in such a manner as to disturb people.
- No motor vehicle shall operate within the Town without a proper muffler.
- 7. No dirt bikes shall operate near housing between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

Noise Regulations

- 8. No person shall play loud music or create excessive Noise so as to disturb neighbors between the hours of 9:00 pm and 8:00 am.
- 9. The use of fireworks within the Town, at any time whatsoever, is prohibited except if carried out further to, and in accordance with, these Regulations.
- 10. Notwithstanding section 9, the Town may, in its sole discretion and upon application, issue a fireworks permit to an individual over the age of 18 allowing for the use of fireworks between 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. Any such permit shall include the conditions that Council considers appropriate but shall, at a minimum, prescribe the place and time where the fireworks are permitted.
- 11. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Regulations, and provided the Town has not issued a ban on fireworks for safety, fire risk or other reasons, fireworks are permitted within the Town without a permit at the following times:
 - (a) Between 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on Victoria Day, Canada Day, Guy Fawkes Night and the day of the Town's Santa Claus Parade; and,
 - (b) Between 4:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve and 1:00 a.m. on New Year's Day.
- 12. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations or a permit issued thereunder is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction:
 - (a) for a first offence to a fine not less than \$100.00 and not exceeding \$500.00 dollars, or to a term of imprisonment for a period not exceeding one month or to both the fine and imprisonment; and,
 - (b) for a subsequent offence to a fine of not less than \$500.00 and not more than \$1000.00 or to a term of imprisonment of not more than 3 months or to both the fine and imprisonment.
- 13. All previous Town Noise Regulations are hereby repealed.
- 14. These Regulations shall come into effect on the _____ day of _____, 2014 and may be cited as the *Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay Noise Regulations*.
