Annual Performance Plan (A.P.P.'S) Community Priorities

- (1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement;**
- (2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property;**
- (3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community**

The 2025/2026 Happy Valley Goose Bay RCMP Annual Performance Plan is currently under development. The APP assigns priorities and goals which help us focus on concerns raised by Detachment Management, Divisional Priorities, and concerns raised by local Stakeholders. The progress of this plan will be monitored throughout the year. The previous years assigned priorities are noted below.

(1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement

Goals have been set for improved Traffic initiatives, with increased traffic enforcement and regular checkstops to help combat Impaired Driving. Members will seek opportunities to conduct strategic checkpoints and partner with Traffic Services to combat Impaired Drivers and HTA Offences.

(2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property

Goals have been set for proactive initiatives to help reduce crimes against persons and property. Detachment members will undertake to implement additional measures to monitor persons bound by court orders to ensure compliance. Regular compliance checks are conducted on persons bound by Court Imposed Conditions to ensure compliance and charges are pursued when persons are found in breach of those conditions.

(3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community

Detachment Commander will ensure there is regular contact and communication with Mayor and Council to ensure any issues are brought forward and plans made to address any identified issues. Members will also seek to further engage with the Community through partnerships and engagement in Community Events. Detachment members continue to try and increase contact with the local youth with regular contact/visits made to local schools. School Liaisons have been appointed to maintain contact with Local Schools.

******The APP is the main objective, outside of responding to calls for service, of the Detachment and helps direct members efforts each and every day.******

Notable Investigations:

20251298302 – Possession of a Weapon – On sept 3rd HVGB RCMP received a report of a male threatening person in Mud Lake. With the Assistance of HVGB GSAR, HVGB RCMP attended the area and arrested a 52 year old male in relation to the Threats investigation. The male was also arrested for Impaired Operation of a Boat, Refusal to provide Breath, Samples, Six counts of uttering threats, Careless use of a Firearm, two counts of possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, and Weapons possession contrary to a court order. The male was held and brought before the court where he was released to appear at a later date

20251317707 – Break and Enter – On September 6th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an Alarm at a local business. Members attended and located a male suspect on the property. The

male fled but located by members a short distance away. A 54 year old male has been arrested and charged with Two counts of B&E, Mischief(Damage to Property), Theft, and Resist Arrest.

20251332757 – Assault with a Weapon – On Sept 8th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an assault. Members attended and located a male victim who required medical attention due to sustained injuries. A 24 year old male was arrested and has been charged with Assault Causing Bodily Harm.

20251345612 – Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking – On Sept 11th HVGB RCMP members were on patrol and conducted a traffic stop. As a result of the traffic stop a 45 year old male was arrested for Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking, Possession of property obtained by Crime, and breaches of a court order.

20251358977 – Impaired Driving – On Sept 13th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a single motor vehicle collision. Upon attending the scene members arrested a 19 year old male for Impaired Operation. The male provided breath samples twice the legal limit. The male was issued a driving suspension and the vehicle was impounded. The male will appear in court at a later date on charges of Impaired Operation

20251362690 – Assault with a Weapon – On Sept 13th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an assault. Members attended and located a male with injuries. A 31 year old male was arrested and charged with Assault with a Weapon, Assault, and Three counts of Breaching a Court Order. A quantity of Cocaine, Cash, and drug paraphernalia was seized. The matter is before the courts.

20251413362 – Assault Causing Bodily Harm – On Sept 22nd HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a disturbance at a residence. Members attended and learned multiple people had been assaulted. Members arrested a 20 year old male for assaulting 5 people. He's been charged with four counts of Assault, Assault Causing Bodily Harm, and Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose. The male was brought before the court and released to appear on a later date

20251417638 – Impaired by Drug – On September 23rd HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an Impaired Driver. Members attended and located a 27 year old female believed to be impaired. During the course of the investigation grounds existed to issue a Blood Demand and the female refused to comply with the Demand. The female was arrested for Refusing to Comply with a Demand. She was issued a driving suspension and the vehicle was towed. The female will appear in court at a later date.

20251444314 – Invitation to Sexual Touching – On Sept 28th HVGB RCMP received a report that an Adult Male had been approaching female youth and making inappropriate comments. Upon investigation a 64 year old male was arrested and is currently facing charges of Invitation to Sexual Touching(2 Counts), Obtaining Sexual Services for Consideration from a person under 18 years(2 Counts) and Obtaining Sexual Services for Consideration(2 Counts). The involved victims are two female youth and two adult females. The male remains in custody awaiting the outcome of a Bail Hearing

20251455780 – Aggravated Assault – On September 30th HVGB RCMP responded to the report of a serious assault. Members attended and located a male victim in need of immediate medical attention, who was transported to the Hospital. A 17 year old male was arrested for Aggravated Assault, Fail to comply with a Court Order and Theft. The Male youth was brought before the court and released to appear at a later date.
