Annual Performance Plan (A.P.P.'S) Community Priorities

- (1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement;**
- (2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property;**
- (3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community**

The 2025/2026 Happy Valley Goose Bay RCMP Annual Performance Plan is currently under development. The APP assigns priorities and goals which help us focus on concerns raised by Detachment Management, Divisional Priorities, and concerns raised by local Stakeholders. The progress of this plan will be monitored throughout the year. The previous years assigned priorities are noted below.

(1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement

Goals have been set for improved Traffic initiatives, with increased traffic enforcement and regular checkstops to help combat Impaired Driving. Members will seek opportunities to conduct strategic checkpoints and partner with Traffic Services to combat Impaired Drivers and HTA Offences.

(2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property

Goals have been set for proactive initiatives to help reduce crimes against persons and property. Detachment members will undertake to implement additional measures to monitor persons bound by court orders to ensure compliance. Regular compliance checks are conducted on persons bound by Court Imposed Conditions to ensure compliance and charges are pursued when persons are found in breach of those conditions.

(3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community

Detachment Commander will ensure there is regular contact and communication with Mayor and Council to ensure any issues are brought forward and plans made to address any identified issues. Members will also seek to further engage with the Community through partnerships and engagement in Community Events. Detachment members continue to try and increase contact with the local youth with regular contact/visits made to local schools. School Liaisons have been appointed to maintain contact with Local Schools.

Notable Investigations:

20251631282 – Break and Enter – On November 2nd HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a Break and Enter at a residential property. RCMP were able to identify and arrest a 34 year old male in relation to the incident and the male has been charged with Break and Enter

20251641781 – Theft of Motor Vehicle – On November 4th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a stolen vehicle. Members were able to locate the vehicle and arrested a 27 year old male in relation to the theft. The male is facing charges of Theft of a Motor Vehicle and Possession of Property obtained by Crime

20251695274 – Possession for Purpose of Trafficking – On November 15th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of unwanted persons at a residence. Upon attending a 37 year old male and a 48 year old female were arrested and found to be in possession of Cocaine, Drug paraphernalia, and Cash. Both have been charged with Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking.

20251691502 -Assault on Police Officer – On November 15th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an intoxicated male causing a disturbance. The 28 year old male was arrested and during the arrest he assaulted two RCMP Officers. The male was charged with Resisting Arrest, Assaulting a Policar, and breach of a court order.

20251705542 – Possession of Cocaine – On November 18th HVGB RCMP were on patrol and conducted a traffic stop. It was learned that the male had a suspended driver licence and in breach of a Court order. A 43 year old male was arrested and during the arrest, the male was also found to be in possession of cocaine. The male is facing four counts of breaching a court order and for Possession of a Controlled Substance. The vehicle was towed/impounded.

20251681718 – Aggravated Assault – On November 24th HVGB RCMP received a report that had assaulted his spouse, resulting in significant injuries. Upon investigation a 27 year old male was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault and will appear in court at a later date

20251754286 – Possession for Purpose of Trafficking – On November 27th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a suspicious male parked in a vehicle. Upon attending members located and arrested a 55 year old male for possession of a controlled substance. During the course of the investigation member located Cocaine, Drug paraphernalia, and Cash. The male has been charged with Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking, Possession of a Prohibited Weapon, Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose, and possession of property obtained by Crime

20251767494 – Robbery – On November 30th HVGB RCMP responded to a report that a Taxi Driver had been assaulted and had items stolen by a male. Members attended and were able to identify the Male. A 27 Year old male was arrested for Robbery. During the arrest the male assaulted several officers. The male has been charged with Robbery, Uttering Threats(X4), Assaulting a Policar(X4), and Breach of a Probation(X2).

20251767052 – Aggravated Assault – On November 30th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an assault in which a male received significant injuries. Upon investigation charges of Aggravated Assault were laid against two males, aged 23 and 36. The 36 year old male was located and brought before the court. The 23 year old male has been evading police and an Arrest Warrant has been issued for his arrest. The injured male was treated for his injuries and released from hospital
