Annual Performance Plan (A.P.P.'S) Community Priorities

- (1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement;**
- (2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property;**
- (3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community**

The 2025/2026 Happy Valley Goose Bay RCMP Annual Performance Plan is currently under development. The APP assigns priorities and goals which help us focus on concerns raised by Detachment Management, Divisional Priorities, and concerns raised by local Stakeholders. The progress of this plan will be monitored throughout the year. The previous years assigned priorities are noted below.

(1) Enhance Road Safety – Improve Road Safety Through Education and Enforcement

Goals have been set for improved Traffic initiatives, with increased traffic enforcement and regular checkstops to help combat Impaired Driving. Members will seek opportunities to conduct strategic checkpoints and partner with Traffic Services to combat Impaired Drivers and HTA Offences.

(2) Crime Reduction – Reduce Crimes against Persons/Property

Goals have been set for proactive initiatives to help reduce crimes against persons and property. Detachment members will undertake to implement additional measures to monitor persons bound by court orders to ensure compliance. Regular compliance checks are conducted on persons bound by Court Imposed Conditions to ensure compliance and charges are pursued when persons are found in breach of those conditions.

(3) Community Relations – Build and Maintain Positive Relations with our Community

Detachment Commander will ensure there is regular contact and communication with Mayor and Council to ensure any issues are brought forward and plans made to address any identified issues. Members will also seek to further engage with the Community through partnerships and engagement in Community Events. Detachment members continue to try and increase contact with the local youth with regular contact/visits made to local schools. School Liaisons have been appointed to maintain contact with Local Schools.

******The APP is the main objective, outside of responding to calls for service, of the Detachment and helps direct members efforts each and every day.******

Notable Investigations:

20251772110 – Break and Enter – On December 1st HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a Break and Enter. Property Owner had located two persons in his property. Members attended and arrested a 33 year old male and a 51 year old female and both have been charged with Break and Enter.

20251779904 – Break and Enter – On December 3rd HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a possible Break and Enter. Members entered the home and located four persons inside. All four were arrested and are facing charges. A 45 year old male is facing charges of Break and Enter, a 32 year old female had attempted to flee during arrest and is facing charges of Break and Enter,

Resist Arrest, and Failing to Comply with a Court Order. A 37 year old female was charged with Break and Enter, and failing to comply with multiple court orders and a 43 year old male was charged with Break and Enter, and failing to comply with a Court Order.

20251786069 – Assault with a Weapon – On December 4th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an Assault with Weapon. Units from HVGB Detachment, Lab District General Investigative Section, and Police Dog Services attended. A 27 year old male was arrested and charged for two counts of Assault with a Weapon and possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose. One victim required medical treatment for his injuries.

20251798747 – Assault Police Officer – On December 7th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an intoxicated female at a local business. Members attended and the female resisted arrest and assaulted both responding officers. The 41 year old female was charged with Resist Arrest and Assaulting a Police Officer and will appear in court at a later date

20251823259 – Assault Police Officer – On December 12th HVGB RCMP Members were dispatched to a report of a disturbance at a local business. Police Dog Services Member arrived on scene and during contact with the subject male, the male assaulted the Officer. A 46 year old male was arrested for assaulting a police officer. The male was also bound by a release order from the court. The male was held and brought before the court and was released to re-appear at a late date.

20251829734 – Flight from Police – On December 14th HVGB RCMP member was on patrol when they attempted to conduct a traffic stop with a male driving an Off Road Vehicle. The vehicle refused to stop and fled from Police. The driver was later identified as a 28 year old male who has since been arrested and charged with Flight. He will appear in court at a later date

20251838767 – Impaired Operation – On December 16th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a possible impaired driver. Members attended and located the suspect vehicle. The 55 year old male driver was showing signs of impairment. The male was arrested and blood samples were provided. Investigation is ongoing pending results from Lab on provided blood samples. The vehicle was impounded and a driving suspension was issued

20251843140 – Break and Enter – On December 17th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a possible break and enter at a vacant building. Members attended and located six person inside the property. All six were arrested and charged for Break and Enter. Those involved included three males aged 44, 47, and 40 along with three females aged 31, 34, and 40.

20251852841 – Sexual Assault – On December 18th HVGB RCMP responded to a report of a disturbance at a residence. Upon attending members located an injured female who reported she

had been assaulted. A 35 year old male was arrested and charged with Assault Causing Bodily Harm and Sexual Assault. The female was transported to the Hospital for medical treatment.

20251866151 – Sexual Assault – On December 21st HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an Assault. During the investigation it was learned that two males had sexually assaulted a female. A 39 year old male was arrested by Sheshatshiu RCMP in relation to this matter and the male has been charged with Sexual Assault, Assault, and Forcible Confinement. An arrest warrant was sought for the other suspect, 44 year old male, who was later arrested by Natuashish RCMP. He too is facing charges of Sexual Assault, Assault, and Forcible Confinement.

20251886348 – Impaired Operation – On December 27th HVGB RCMP members were on patrol and located a vehicle off the road. Members located the driver in the vehicle who was showing signs of impairment. The 30 year old female was arrested for Impaired Operation. The female provided breath samples that were over three times the legal limit. The female is facing charges of Impaired Operation and Driving Over 80. The vehicle was towed and the female was issued a driving suspension.

20251906240 – Assault Police Officer – On December 31st HVGB RCMP responded to a report of an Assault. Members attended and arrested a 56 year old male. During the arrest, the male assaulted the responding member. The male is facing charges of Assault, Assaulting a Police Officer, Resist Arrest, and Fail to comply with a Court Order
